In the contemporary global landscape, human rights and constitutional law stand at a pivotal crossroads, shaped by unprecedented challenges such as digital surveillance, climate-induced displacements, algorithmic biases in governance, and evolving notions of gender and identity justice. India's constitutional framework, enshrined in the world's longest written constitution, exemplifies this dynamic interplay—balancing individual liberties with state responsibilities while harmonizing with international human rights norms.



The rationale for this conference is rooted in the pressing need to bridge the gap between theoretical advancements in human rights and constitutional law and their practical implementation. Recent judicial pronouncements, such as the Supreme Court of India's rulings on privacy as a fundamental right and environmental constitutionalism, underscore the judiciary's proactive role. Yet, emerging issues like AI-driven decision-making, data sovereignty in the post-GDPR era, and the constitutional implications of climate litigation remain underexplored in Indian academia.



The 1st CLRS-SSSCL Conference on Human Rights & Constitutional Law emerges as a timely initiative to address these shifts. ## Call for Papers

The themes of **‘Emerging Trends in Human Rights Law & Constitutional Law’** reflect an inherently interdisciplinary and intersectional approach that is crucial in contemporary times. As societal, technological, and geopolitical transformations accelerate, they challenge entrenched legal paradigms, reshaping the balance between individual liberties, state authority, and collective justice. To achieve the objectives of the Conference, participants are invited to make critical analyses of human rights and constitutional law treaties, protocols, policies, and other instruments at international and domestic levels. In addition, the participants are encouraged to undertake country- or region-specific studies on the enforcement success or failure of various laws and policies related to the protection and promotion of human rights and constitutional principles in areas such as digital privacy and surveillance, algorithmic bias and AI governance, climate justice and environmental constitutionalism, gender equality and LGBTQ+ inclusion, migrant and refugee protections, indigenous sovereignty and cultural rights, health equity and pandemic responses, freedom of expression amid misinformation, disability-inclusive frameworks, corporate accountability for human rights abuses, economic inequalities and socio-economic rights, judicial activism and constitutional morality, data protection and cyber liberties, trade agreements and rights harmonization, intellectual property in the context of access to knowledge, eradication of discrimination, promotion of intersectional equity, mitigation of socio-political conflicts, food and water security as fundamental rights, ocean governance and marine human rights, air pollution and public health entitlements, deforestation and land rights, waste management through sustainable constitutional duties, moral and ethical dilemmas in emerging biotechnologies, etc.

## Eligibility

Submissions are open to legal scholars, practitioners, students, technologists, policymakers, and other stakeholders with an interest in the Human Rights & Constitutional Law

## Submission Guidelines

We invite original, unpublished research papers (3,000-6,000 words, including footnotes) that align with the conference theme and sub-themes. Papers should demonstrate rigorous analysis, originality, and relevance to contemporary legal challenges. Empirical studies, comparative analyses, and interdisciplinary approaches are particularly encouraged.

## Abstract Submission

- 250-300 words, accompanied by 5-7 keywords.
- Include title, author(s) name(s), affiliation(s), email, and a brief bio (50 words max per author).

# Full Paper Submission

1. **Language:** English only.
2. **Formatting:** MS Word (.docx), Times New Roman, 12-point font, 1.5 line spacing, justified alignment, A4 margins (1 inch all sides).
3. **Referencing:** Bluebook 21st Edition (consistent throughout). Footnotes for citations; no endnotes.
4. **Structure:** Abstract, Introduction, Main Body (with sub-headings), Conclusion, References.
5. **Plagiarism Policy:** All submissions will be checked using Turnitin or equivalent software. Similarity index must not exceed 15% (excluding references).

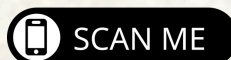
